## Day 80: Wednesday, May 3 and Friday, May 4 Elie Wiesel uses repetition to describe his first night in the concentration camp. He writes,

"Never shall I forget that night, the first night in camp, that turned my life into one long night seven times sealed.

"Never shall I forget the small faces of the children whose bodies I saw transformed into smoke under a silent sky.

"Never shall I forget those flames that consumed my faith forever...

The repetition of the words "Never shall I forget" creates emphasis. Such use of repetition is called anaphora or litany. For today's journal play with the use of repetition and create your own litany poem. It can be about your life, school, family, a boyfriend/girlfriend, a relative, an event, a memory, or anything else. Be creative and have fun!
