You realize a certain part of the text is important. Why do you think it's important? What about it is important? What does it mean? Make a connection to your life.

- 1. Write at least five detailed, complete sentences.
- 2. Introduce and properly place a quote (could be as short as a phrase or as long as a sentence or two). The quote needs to support the point you are making.
- 3. Include an in-text citation. Cite the page number, paragraph number (for readings without page numbers), or book/scene and line number (for plays and poetry).
- 4. Develop an original thought about why the passage is significant. (claim/opinion)
- 6. Discuss what in the evidence you presented backs up your original thought and describe how it backs it up.
